This indenture made the Eleventh day of
August in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and sixty two between

William Mc Thomas Esqur Commissioner of the Honorable Court of
Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the Said
State of the our part and Charles J Elford Esqur of the other
part Whereas Sarah Ponder on or about the Eighth day of
April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
fifty seven exhibited her bill of complaint in the Court of Equity
at Greenville Court House in the Said State against Daniel
Stanford and Claiborn Grammell for the Partition of the
lands of Elizabeth Stanford late of Greenville District and
the cause being at issue before the honorable Court came on to
be heard at July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty seven when the said Court after full
hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did
order adjudge and decree that said land should be sold at
Public auction by the said Court on the terms and for the pur-
poses mentioned in their decretal order as by reference thereto in
the registry of the said Court will appear and the said Samuel
A Lowndes as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly
advertised the said land for sale by public outcry on the sales-
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
dred and fifty seven did then openly and publicly and according
to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said land below
described unto the said Charles J Elford Esqur for fourteen
hundred Dollars being at that price the highest bidder for
the same Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the
said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court
under and by virtue of the said Deem and in consideration
of the sum of Three dollars paid him by the said Charles J
Elford Esqr the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Charles J Elford
Esqur and his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel
of land situate in Greenville District of this State containing
two hundred acres more or less upon Musc Creek adjo-
ining lands of Estate of C Stand deceased Grammell Allen
and others being the land described by Phillip Sheril to
Elizabeth Stanford as will appear from his last will and
testament bearing date the 4th day of March A.D 1802 and
recorded in the office of ordinary for Greenville District
Together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members
and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in
anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders rents
Issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest

both at law and equity of the heirs and representatives of the
