Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said B R Campbell as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Two Thous and Seven hundred and sixty dollars paid him by the said James M Sullivan the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said James M Sullivan his heirs and assigns all that tract of land in Greenville District on Reedy River bounded on the South by lands at present owned by John C Sullivan John Terry and James Mc Lattimore on the West by the said John C Sullivan on the North by Mrs Temperance Gannels and on the East by said River containing .587 acres and more particularly described by a plat of the same made by Samuel Moon bearing date the 12th of May 1851 and hereto attached subject however to a reservation of about 27th acres constituting the family grave yard of said testator and the road leading thento as designated in said plat. Together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of Land belonging or in anywise appertaining. And the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest & power property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Hewlet Sullivan Jr and of all the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by claim or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said Tract of land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances unto the said James M Sullivan his heirs and assigns to him and his only proper use benefit and behoof.
