

Secondly In trust to deliver to Mrs Jane McCoy mother of the said Franklin Cox all the property real or personal before described if any remain after paying off & satisfying said debts & all the proceeds & profits of the same remaining after paying all charges hereby incurred, and the said Franklin Cox doth hereby declare that upon the payment of his said debts or so much of them as the proceeds of the said property real & personal will satisfy & in case there should be any remaining after paying the said debts upon the delivery to the said Mrs Jane McCoy of the surplus as aforesaid then said trusts shall cease and determine, and the land and ~~proceeds~~ & personal property so delivered over to the said Mrs Jane McCoy shall belong in fee simple absolute to her her heirs forever, and the said parties of the second part do hereby signify their acceptance of this trust and do hereby covenant and agree to & with the said party of the first part faithfully to discharge & execute the same according to the true intent & meaning of these presents.

In witness whereof the said parties of the first part and of the second part have hereunto set their hand & seal this 25th day of February AD 1863, sealed & delivered in presence of us the last word in the second line on the recent page being first erased also the words one thousand in 344th line same page having been crossed & the words seven hundred interlined between the 344th line &
