Know all men by these presents
 that I Julius H Earle of the State and District above named for
 and in consideration of the sum of four thousand four hundred Dollars
 \$4500, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sold and release unto Archibald H Lester his heirs and
 assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying and
 being in the State and District above named on Enoree River known
 as the place wherein Thomas P Brockman formerly resided and hav-
 ing such marks and bounds as shown on a plat made by Wm Mc
 Grisham dated November the Thirteenth and fourteenth one
 thousand Eight hundred and sixty one (1861), the said plat attached
 to a deed made by David Anderson Executor of Thomas P.
 Brockman to Julius H Earle adjoining lands of James Anderson
 of C Hilgoe J J Jones and others containing nine hundred and
 two acres, 902, more or less together with all and singular
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances there-
 unto belonging to have and to hold the said premises above
 mentioned and described and hereby granted and conveyed
 with the appurtenances unto the said Archibald H Lester
 his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper benefit
 and behoof forever and the said Julius H Earle for himself
 his heirs executors administrators and assigns doth covenant
 promise and agree to and with the said Archibald H Lester
 his heirs and assigns that the said Archibald H Lester his
 heirs and assigns shall and lawfully may from time to time
 and forever hereafter peaceably and quietly have hold use occu-
 py and possess all and singular the said hereditaments and
 premises hereby granted and conveyed without any lawful let hind-
 erance suit or Water-upton whatsoever of or from the said Julius
 H Earle his heirs and assigns or from or by any other person or
 persons whatsoever lawfully claiming; and the said Earle will
 forever warrant and defend the above convey ~~ad~~ premises with
 the appurtenances unto the said Lester his heirs and assigns
 against the claim of himself his executors administrators
 and assigns and against the claim of any other person
