Montgomery a certain piece parcel or tract of Land containing thirty eight acres in the same more or less situate in the District and State aforesaid on branches of Enoree the River, beginning at Red oak 3+ 0 m thence S 39 1/2 E 52.80 chs to Rock 3+ 0 m in the edge of a Swamp thence S 28 1/2 W 12.50 chs to Rock 3+ in an old fence Row thence N 50 W 53.00 chs to Rock 3+ in the Gap creek Road thence N 60 W 2.80 chs to the beginning being part of a Tract originally granted to Peggy Lewis, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said C. C. Montgomery his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said C. C. Montgomery his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
