The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound James Mc Allen his heirs Executars or administratars Shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named Mrs Mc Enston as her certain attorney Execu- tors or administratars or assigns the full and just sum of One Thousand Dollars on the first day of July one thous- and Eight hundred and Sixty Eight with the interest semiannually at the rate of Seven per cent per annum then the above obligation to be void and of none effect or else to remain in full force and virtue Sealed and delivered in the presence of $\frac{3}{3}$ James Mc Allen $\frac{3}{3}$ J Kitchen J Wildman</p>
