 Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville  
 District at Greenville Court House in the said State of  
 the one part and Edwin F Gridley of the other part. Whereas  
 Edwin F Gridley on or about the Sixteenth day of October in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty three exhibited  
 his bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House  
 in the said State against Louisa A Gridley a minor to receive  
 a little to a legal interest which had descended upon her  
 though her mother Elizabeth Gridley deceased, and the  
 answering said Bill by her Guardian ad litem, her  
 father Edward Gridley, and the cause being at issue  
 before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at chambers  
 term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and Sixty three when the said court after full hearing  
 thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order  
 adjudge and decree that the Commissioner in Equity should  
 convey said minors interest in the lot of land described in  
 the said Bill to the complainant. Now therefore this indenture  
 witnesseth that the said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of  
 the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consid-  
 eration of the sum of Five Dollars paid him by the said Edwin F  
 Gridley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted  
 bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant  
 bargain sell and release unto the said Edwin F Gridley and his  
 heirs and assigns all the interest of the minor Louisa A Gridley  
 in and to a lot of land situate lying and being in the Town of Green-  
 ville in the District of Greenville of this State described in the  
 Bill in this case and formerly conveyed by Vandy Mc Bee to Elizabeth  
 Gridley deceased. Together with all and singular the heredita-  
 ments rights Members and Appurtenances whatsoever  
 to the said Land belonging or in anywise appertaining, and  
 the reversions and remainders unto issues and profits there-  
 and also all the estate rights title interest dower possession  
 property benefit claim and demand whatsoever bath at  
 law and Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said  
 Louisa Gridley and of the parties to this suit, and of all  
 other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
 part thereof by from or under them or either of them, to have and to  
 hold the said interest in the said land with its hereditaments  
 privileges and appurtenances unto the said Edwin F Gridley  
 and his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use benefit  
 and behoof forever.
