 of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Two
 Hundred Dollars \$200, to us paid by Daniel Burg of Greenville District
 in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Daniel
 Burg, all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and
 being between the Anderson Road and the Greenville and Columbia
 Rail Road in the suburbs of the town of Greenville in the District
 and State aforesaid, containing one acre one rod and thirty seven
 perches more or less, adjoining lands of Thomas C Gower et al and
 having the following lines metes and bounds as set forth in a plat
 of the same made by William A Hudson I S and attached to this deed
 viz, beginning at a Stake 3+0 m and running thence N 03 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 5.07 to a B.C.
 3+0 m thence N 90 $\frac{1}{4}$ W 3.27 to a Stake 3+0 m, thence N 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 3.09 to a Stake
 3+0 m thence N 26 E 2.02 to the begining corner, together with all and
 singular the rights members hereditaments and appertaining to the land
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 Daniel Burg his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind
 ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
 Daniel Burg his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and every
 other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
