The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Robert Greenfield of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Seventy five thousand dollars to me paid by Christian Heahn of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Christian Heahn all that Lot or parcel of land in the village of Greenville in the said State situate lying & being as follows, To wit, measuring on the north two hundred feet on Coffee Street on the East one hundred & twenty feet on McBe Street, on the South two hundred feet on a lot belonging to Thomas Allen deceased or by Elias Montgomery and on the west one hundred & seventy feet on Spring Street on which Lot is situated a brick house lately purchased by me at Commissioners Sale & was recently occupied by Mr Lass which house & Lot was bargained by me to the said Christian Heahn on the 27th day of October 1863. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Christian Heahn his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Christian Heahn his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof — Witness my hand and seal this first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty four and in the third year of the Independence of the State of South Carolina
