Nealy then to Mr. Fuller then to Glenning Fuller then John Gasmell and William Brewitt and bounded as follows begins beginning at a chestnut oak 3+3+ S. E. down the ridge to a black gum on the branch N. W. up the branch to a maple in the fork of the branch N. West up the ridge to a dogwood on the top of the Mountain North to the out side line thence beginning the conditional line made between my self and John Gasmell it being agreed upon between ourselves John Gasmell part containing four hundred acres more or less.
