Amelia Coleman To C. H. Judson	Deed For Land	The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I, Amelia Coleman of Laurens District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Seven Hundred and Ninety Seven dollars to me paid by C. H. Judson of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said C. H. Judson all that piece of land formerly a portion of the real estate of the late John Coleman deceased situated near the Town of Greenville in the said State containing Seventeen and one half acres more or less and bounded as follows, Viz, beginning at a Stake in the middle of the new road on the line separating the land lately owned by Dr. W. Manly for running thence along said line S 65° 12' 67.4 chs to an east 3+ N in the branch just below the Spring, thence along said branch to a stone 3+ in the ford on the line of P. C. Edwards and of W. B. Brooks thence S 7 W along the line of W. B. Brooks 16.2 chs to a stone 3+ thence N 83° W 18.32 chs along the line dividing lots No 5 & 6 to a Stake in the middle of the road thence N 7 E along the middle of the ^{said} road a distance of 8.32 chs to the place of beginning Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditam ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said C. H. Judson his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said C. H. Judson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
