Know all men by these presents
 that I John Dawson Smith of the District and State aforesaid in consideration of the love and affection I bear to my daughter Emily G Smith and for divers other considerations and causes me therunto moving and for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to me paid by Henry McSmith have given and conveyed and by these presents do give and convey unto the said Henry McSmith Trustee all that tract of Land which I devised in my will and which will I now have in possession, to my son Lewis R Smith recently deceased containing three hundred acres more or less also the following slave to wit a girl named Lena also the following property to wit Two Beds and furniture one set of Windsor chairs one Settee Bookings utensials One horse one cow and calf Four Sheep and Four Hogs such as she may choose, and she has the right to select all of the above named property except the land and negro. In Trust nevertheless that said land and slave and the increase of said slave and all the other property named above in this deed are to be held and kept and employed for the sole use and benefit of my said daughter Emily G Smith for and during her natural life free from any charge for the debts contracts or liabilities of any husband she may marry and at her death the said property Except such as may perish in the using of it, and the future increase of the said slave to be equally divided
