 to me paid by William Bates Thomas Mc Cox and Henry P. Ham-
 mett of the said District and State being and composing the
 firm of William Bates & Co. We have granted bargained sold and
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said William Bates Thomas Mc Cox and Henry P.
 Hammett all that piece parcel and tract of land containing
 Seventeen Hundred and three and one half acres (1703 1/2)
 more or less situate lying and being on both sides of Reedy
 River in the District and State aforesaid adjoining lands of
 Sam Young Hawkinis Cleveland Shockley & Benson Cleveland
 and others and having the following lines marks and bounds
 as represented by a plat of the same made by James E. Dickson
 L.S. for 19th November 1863 and annexed to this Deed. Viz, beginning
