

F A Miles Deed The State of South Carolina  
 To Know all men by these presents  
 Jas N Taylor for Land that I Francis A Miles of Greenville  
 District in the State aforesaid in  
 consideration of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars to me  
 paid by James N Taylor of Greenville District in the State  
 aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these  
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James  
 N Taylor his heirs and assigns all that piece parcel and tract  
 of land situate lying and being in the said District & State  
 on the waters of Brush Creek adjoining lands of Barnett  
 Neaves and others containing three hundred & ten and three  
 quarter acres more or less, and having such lines metes and  
 bounds as is represented by a plat of the same herunto  
 attached being the same land conveyed to me by Moses  
 Fowler by Deed of November 5<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1807, together with all  
 and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
 to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurte-  
 nancing. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises  
 unto the said James N Taylor his heirs and assigns forever, and  
 I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administra-  
 tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 premises unto the said James N Taylor his heirs and assigns  
 against me and my heirs and against every other person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
 thereof. Witness my hand and seal this seventh day of December  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty  
 three & in the Eighty Eighth year of the Sovereignty of the State
