D. Ogle be liable therefor then it shall and may be lawful for and I the said Adam Hoffenknecht hereby authorise and command the said Augustus Hocke and Charles W. D. Ogle their Executors administrators and assigns with the rule and assistance of any person or persons to enter into abiding house and such other place or places as the said goods or chattels are or may be, and take and carry away the said goods and chattels and to sell and dispose of the same for the best price they can obtain and out of the money arising thereby to pay themselves for all losses and damages sustained by them by reason of the partnership aforesaid rendering the covenants if any such, sum or to my executors administrators and assigns and until default be made as aforesaid I am to remain and continue in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said goods and chattels and the full and free enjoyment of the same.

 Know all men by these presents that I the
 St. O'Neal of Greenville District in the State
 aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Sixty
 Thousand Dollars to me paid by G. W. Morse of Greenville District in the State
 aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said G. W. Morse the lot of land on
 which he now resides situated on Burlington Street left of the Franklin road about
 one mile west of Greenville Court House in the District of Greenville beginning at a
 corner on Burlington Street & running thence with said street S. W. 84° 40' feet to
 a street 60 feet wide thence with said street N. E. 84° 40' feet to a street S. W. on corner
 of McPhersons line thence with said line S. W. 20° 00' 40' feet to a street on a street 60
 feet wide thence with said line S. W. 84° 40' feet to the beginning containing five
 acres one hundred & fifteen poles more or less. In trust nevertheless that the said
 G. W. Morse & his successors shall annually collect the rents issues & profits thereof
 and after paying all just charges & expenses on the said lot shall pay the balance
 to Mrs. Marianne Morse for her sole support & maintenance and on her separate
 receipt during her life free from all debts contracts and liabilities of her present
 or any future husband. Secondly In trust after the death of the said Mrs. Marianne
 Morse then the said trustee to convey the said lot & premises to such person or
 persons as she shall have specifically notwithstanding her coveting by deed or
 will appointed to receive the same. And in default of such appointment then the said
 trustee aforesaid or his successor shall convey the same to the heirs at law of
 the said Mrs. Marianne Morse to be divided amongst them according to the
 statutes of distribution of this State. Thirdly In trust that the said G. W. Morse
 shall sell release and convey in fee or otherwise the said lot and premises to such
 person or persons as the said Mrs. Marianne Morse shall indicate by her written
 request and he shall invest the proceeds in other property which shall be
 subject to priority the same trustee as the lot of land aforesaid. Fourtly In trust
 that the said G. W. Morse shall by deed or last will and testament appoint his
 successor in the trust hereby created and in case of his death without having
 made such appointment the said Mr. Morse shall have power to appoint by
 writing under her hand and seal a trustee for all the purposes of his deed
 together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appur-
 tenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said G. W. Morse for the uses and trusts aforesaid to him his executors and his
 heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors
 and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said G. W. Morse heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
 & every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof or words of affiance intended before signing \$74,800, feet to a street to put with them with
 said street.
