by William Sprossen of the District and State aforesaid, witnesseth Thomas Peter Cauble of the District and State aforesaid has Inhabited himself as tenant to a promissory note to one Bartlett Grogan of same District and State aforesaid with me for a certain sum of One Hundred Dollars bearing date with these presents and due 25th July 1866. Now therefore to have and keep Cauble the said Cauble owing sum on said Note, I do hereby grant bargain sell and release unto the said Peter Cauble said horse known and described as follows, bay color and about ten years old and the same horse purchased by said Grogan from one Miles Watson some four years ago. The said Sprossen also bargains and sells in addition to the horse above described and for the purpose and in consideration above of his tenancy above mentioned a certain red Cow the same that the said Sprossen purchased three years since from Alexander Norton to have and to hold the said horse and cow unto the said Cauble his heirs executors administrators and assigns and against me my heirs executors administrators and assigns or any other person lawfully claiming the same. It is the true intent of the parties to these presents that if the said Sprossen pay or cause to be paid unto the said Grogan the sum of one hundred dollars and interest and save the said Cauble harmless in the payment of the same or any part thereof then these presents shall be utterly null and void. It is further the intent of these presents until default shall be made in payment of the sum aforesaid it may be lawful for the said Sprossen peaceably and quietly to hold the same and enjoy the service of the said Cauble above mentioned till these my hand and seal day and place above written sealed and delivered in the presence of
