Know all men by these presents that  
we W. C. Goodwin & Joseph McGoodwin  
of Greenville District in the aforesaid  
State in consideration of One Hundred & Fifty Dollars to us paid by  
John Gosnell of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid have  
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said John Gosnell Two pieces parcels  
or tracts of land containing Seventy Acres more or less it being part of  
a tract of Four hundred & eight acres of land originally granted to Thomas  
Goodwin the 24<sup>th</sup> day February 1792 & witness to us by Th. Goodwin and runs  
as follows. Beginning on a Red Oak 34 N 82° 50' to a N 03° thence N 53 E 6.00  
chains to a pine 34 thence N 53 E to said Gosnells line thence along said  
Gosnells line till it intersects a line of S 2° E and thence N 35 W thence along  
S 2° line to the beginning & being bounded on all sides by said Gosnells land  
the other piece runs as follows beginning at a S 2° thence E 29 622.00 chains  
to a Stake 34 thence S 53 W 35.00 chains to a Red oak 34 thence to the beginning 34  
bounded by lands of said Gosnell Mr R. Barton & John Lownes  
together with all and singular the rights members heretofore amounts  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said John Gosnell his heirs  
and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind our selves our heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said John Gosnell his heirs  
and assigns against us and our heirs lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof.

the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America

This indenture made the Twenty third  
day of October in the year of our Lord  
One thousand and eight hundred and Sixty five between George  
F. Lownes and W. A. Lownes of the one part and Rebecca  
Payne of the other part. Witnesseth whereas the said George  
F. Lownes and W. A. Lownes have this day granted

bargained and sold unto the said Rebecca Payne a certain  
tract and parcel of land hereinafter described for the sum of Eight  
hundred dollars in Specie five hundred of which sum has been paid  
by said Rebecca Payne and wheras she has given her promissory  
note bearing date with indenture payable twelve months after  
date thereof with interest from date for the sum of Three Thousand  
Dollars the remainder of the said purchase money. Now this Indenture  
witnesseth that the said Rebecca Payne for and in consideration  
of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of  
ten dollars paid to the said Rebecca Payne by the said George F.  
Lownes and W. Augustus Lownes at and before the sealing and delivery  
of these presents have granted bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
George F. Lownes and W. Augustus Lownes all that tract and  
parcel of land known and described as follows to wit. Beginning  
at a stake near Brush Creek and running thence S 61 W 07 ch to a  
stake 34 thence S 61 W 03 65 to a Spanish oak 34 thence S 2 E 75 to a  
stake 34 thence S 61 W 3.92 to a Red oak 34 thence S 61 E 8.50 to a Stake  
thence N 51 E 7.50 to a small pine thence N 41 E 2.50 to a poplar 34  
thence along with the meanderings of the said Brush Creek to a White  
oak 03 4 thence N 61 W 3.60 ch to a poplar 34 thence N 41 W 2.50 to the  
beginning containing in all Twenty three and one half acres and all  
of which said lands are lying and being situate in the State and District  
aforesaid and are bounded by lands of G. F. Lownes W. Augustus Lownes and  
Adam Snyder. Together with all and singular the rights members heredita-  
ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said George F. Lownes and W. Augustus Lownes  
their heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my heirs executors  
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said George F. Lownes W. Augustus Lownes their  
heirs and assigns against myself and heirs and against every person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of  
the parties to these presents that if the said Rebecca Payne her heirs  
executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid  
unto the said George F. Lownes and W. Augustus Lownes the sum of Three  
hundred Dollars according to the note and obligation aforesaid  
then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void  
anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding  
and it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties  
to these presents that until default shall be made in payment of the  
aforesaid sum as before set forth and the interest for the same it shall  
and may be lawful to and for the said Rebecca Payne peaceably and  
quietly to hold use occupy and enjoy all and singular the premises aforesaid  
granted and released and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have  
receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to her own particular  
use and behoof anything herein contained to be contrary thereto in anywise  
notwithstanding. In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto
