Grady & Hawthorne So. 100	Mortgage	The State of South Carolina This Covenant and Mortgage made the day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six between John W Grady and David O Hawthorne of the first part and Samuel G Wyman George H Boyd William Gregg Jr and James C Smith known trading and dealing under the name of the firm of Wyman Boyd and Company of the city of New York of the second part witnesses as follows. Whereas by a previous arrangement made since the first of January last the firm of Grady Hawthorne and Perry of Greenville District in this state of which the said first party over members were allowed to draw upon the said second party for a large amount of money and to pay the same by shipments of Cotton yarn to said second party for sale and since then the said firm of Grady Hawthorne and Perry has been dissolved by mutual consent and the said first party becomes liable and responsible for the balance due said second party by virtue of the agreement made in accordance therewith by the second party to the said firm of Grady Hawthorne and Perry over and above the shipments of said firm to the said second party and whereas said second have agreed and by the acceptance of these presents do agree with said first party to close the account of the said firm of Grady Hawthorne and Perry and charge the balance due by said firm to said the said first party and further to advance for said first party upon their drafts or bills of exchange drawn upon them the second party a certain sum of money which with the balance transferred from the account of said firm of Grady Hawthorne & Perry shall amount to the sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars over and above the usual advancements made by consignment, and as has been agreed upon by the said second party with the firm of Grady Hawthorne & Perry therefore in consideration of these presents and the sum of five dollars in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said first party covenant and agree with the said second party to ship to them the said second party upon comission and for sale upon comission the manufacature and production of the McBee Factory of Greenville District of this state of which they are the sole proprietors until their said account and the advancements above mentioned shall be fully and satisfactory balanced and paid, and for the same consideration they the said first party have granted bargained sold released conveyed and mortgaged and by these presents do grant bargain and release convey and mortgage to the said second party all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville District of this state on Reedy River adjoining lands of J H Ashmore and others containing four hundred and thirty nine acres more or less known as the McBee Factory tract of land and more particularly described in a conveyance from Varday McBee to John W Grady David O Hawthorne and William Perry recorded in the office of the Register
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of Deeds Conveyances for Greenville District of this state. Together
with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments appurte-
nances, mills houses, machinery and privileges thereunto belonging
or in any wise incident, to the same and to hold the same to them
the said second party, their heirs and assigns forever. Provided
always and it is the express understanding of these presents
that if the said first party shall fail to pay or settle this account
with said second party, so that they the said second party shall be
fully informed and satisfied then and thenceforth this present
shall be utterly null and void and of no effect whatsoever con-
cerning to the contrary herein contained notwithstanding, and it is
further covenanted and promised that the said first party
shall have months one which to settle the above account
and a further time thereafter until the said second party shall
have given them the first party three months notice of their discon-
tinuance the above arrangements or covenant.
