Boyce in and by my certain Bond or obligation bearing date the seventh day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty six stand firmly held and bound unto Cornelius L. Burchmeyer, trustee in the penal sum of forty five thousand and one hundred and twenty dollars condition for the payment of the full and just sum of twenty three thousand and sixty dollars, with interest thereon from the first day of October One thousand eight hundred and sixty five, the whole payable six months from the date thereof, as in and by the said Bond and condition thereof referred being thence had well more fully appear. Now know all men that I the said James P. Boyce in consideration of the said debt and sum of Money as aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Cornelius L. Burchmeyer trustee according to the condition of the said Bond, and also in consideration of the further sum of three dollars to me the said James P. Boyce in hand well and truly paid by the said Cornelius L. Burchmeyer trustee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said James P. Boyce have granted bargained sold assigned and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell assign and release unto the said Cornelius L. Burchmeyer trustee all that piece parcel and lot of land in the city of Charleston and State aforesaid on the south side of Royal Street called in the planter of the City Land Company Lands No 10 Royal Street designated on Paynes plat of the said land by No 8 Meaning According to said plat 22 feet back on Royal Street and taken on Southward line and in depth 117 feet 2 inches back lot of land having been assigned to the said Boyce by a deed of indenture made 15th day 1850 between Henry W. Casner Esq. M. W. Boyce and Geo H. Kelly of Charleston and Geo Washington Carter and Henry Arnold Foster of N.Y. of the first part and the Boyce of Charleston of second part the Star Name upon the same being Number 11 point City Number the said deed being recorded in Books G. N. D. pag 376 Office of Register of Deeds conveyance for Charleston District in said State. And also all that piece parcel and tract of land containing One hundred and twenty eight acres more or less situated
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lying and being within and adjoining the corporate limits
of the town of Greenville in said State and having the following
lines poles and bounds viz beginning at a Stake 34 in the middle
of the Laurens road, at the corner of the land of the Episcopal
church and running thence with the middle of said road 171
& forty chains to a Stake at a bend in said road thence still with
the middle of said road 171 & eight chains and fifty links to a
Stake at the junction of the Spartanburg road, thence still with
the middle of the Laurens road 171 & three chains to a Stake
at a bend in road thence still with the middle of said road 171 &
ten chains and eighty four links to a Stake at bend in road thence
still with the middle of said road 170 & fourteen chains and
sixty five links to a Stake 34 thence with the middle of said road
thirty six chains and forty four links to a Stake 34 formerly a string
thence with Cleveland road 175 & 10 twenty eight chains and forty
five links to a 30 34 thence still with Cleveland road 174 & 10

to them and to hold all and singular the said premises unto
the said Cornelius L. Burchmeyer trustee his heirs and assigns
forever. And I the said James P. Boyce do hereby bind my self
my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Cornelius
L. Burchmeyer trustee, his heirs and assigns against me and
my heirs and against any other person whosever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Provided
always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning
of the parties to these presents, that if I the said James P.
