ining two acres more or less situate lying and being in the
Town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid and
having the following lines meted and bounds that is to say
beginning at a Stake corner of Washington Street and Street
forty wide running behind the lot and Wallce W Green lot
and running thence with Washington Street to a Stake at
the S E corner thereof with Col S D Goodlett line
two hundred and fifty feet to a Stake at Col McGaughans
line with C M McGaughans line one hundred and
twenty feet to a Stake on street forty feet wide and thence with
said street two hundred and fifty and a half feet to the begin-
ning being the lot as at present enclosed on which I reside
and which was conveyed to me by J Mauldin by deed 10. Decr
1857 together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Bond
Interest and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said, William
T Lester, Archibald Lester and George W Lester their heirs and
assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Exec-
utors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said premises unto the said William T Lester
Archibald Lester and George W Lester their heirs and
assigns against me and my Heirs and every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of

sixty three and in the third year of the Independence of the
Confederate States of America.

paid by J. A. King of the State and District aforesaid and Trustee
for Mrs Harriet M. Randal have granted bargained sold and
Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said J. A. King a certain piece or parcel of land lying
and being in the District and State aforesaid for the use and
benefit of the said Harriet M. Randal her heirs and assigns
forever it being a part of the Richard Tract lying on the
south East side of the Long Branch of Rock Creek water of Enore
River beginning at a Stake on the Augusta Road, J. A. Green corner
and running Thence S 88 E 119.60 to River now & Thence E 20.61, 28
to Stone & Thence E 74.70 to Stone on old line Thence S 27 E 27.20
to Holly on the Long Branch Thence down the meanders of
the said Branch to a Poplar & Thence S 66 E 28.00 to Stake on the
Road S. B. Hutchings corner Thence with the meanders of said
Road to the beginning containing Sixty five and a half Acres be
the same more or less together with all and singular the rights
members, bonds, tenements and Appurtenances thereto belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining with the exception of
the house that Mrs. Nancy Fowler now lives in which belongs
to the Estate of P. J. Fowler dec'd and is to be removed at the death
of the said Nancy Fowler and the said Nancy Fowler is also to leave
the few rods of her Sons of ground around the house during her life
to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said
J. A. King Trustee as before mentioned for the use of the said Harriet
M. Randal her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself
as Trustee my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant
and forever defend the said premises unto the said J. A. King as
Trustee as before mentioned for the use of the said Harriet M. Randal
and her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and exec-
utors and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claim-
ing or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witnes my hand and
