Depot in 6 days from date of Invoice of cotton excepting 1.5 Bales.  
If Mc Thomas will forfeit 10 per cent per week on all balances that go  
beyond 30 days from shipment of cotton in Columbia when such  
shipment is not met by the agreed shipment of yarn. If these  
conditions are complied with then this Bond to be null and void  
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. 26 May 1867
