

Martha Loveland	Deed to John Watson	for Land
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The State of South Carolina  
Whereas by Decree of the Honorable  
Court of Equity of said State in the  
case of John Watson against Martha  
Loveland, trustee and co-trustee, and others, the said Martha  
Loveland was ordered and directed to convey to the said John  
Watson a certain tract of land in the proceedings of said case  
described upon the delivery to the said Martha Loveland by the  
said John Watson, or a certain Mortgage, and certain Sealed Notes  
in said proceedings set forth. Now know all men by these presents that  
the Martha Loveland of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for  
and in consideration of the premises aforesaid, the said John Watson  
having delivered to me the Mortgage and the sealed Notes aforesaid  
I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do  
grant & bargain sell and release unto the said John Watson all that  
piece of land and tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville  
District and State of South Carolina and having the following lines, poles  
and bounds, by, beginning at a W.C. 34 on the bank of Saluda River  
Thence 170 87 chs to a Blk. C. 34 Thence 120 4.50 chs to a B.C. 34 Thence 70  
334. chs to a R.C. 34 Thence 121 83.70 chs to a S.C. Stamp 3+4 pointers. Thence  
169 64 chs to a Blk. C. 34 Thence 122 83.70 chs to a low C. 34 on the creek above  
old mill Pond, thence by said creek about 3 chs to a state below stone when  
mill house formerly stood. Thence 172 83.51 chs to a large chestnut S.C. Thence  
170 10 33 chs to a state 34 Thence 170 87 chs to a state by a W.C. on a creek  
thence down said creek and ditch to a state 34 Thence 133 12.40 chs to  
a state on Saluda River above the mouth of Mill Creek. Thence down  
said river to the beginning corner. The said tract containing One hundred  
and Ninety five acres, and being the same tract conveyed to me as trustee  
by Isabella J.P. Stoll by the said John Watson by Deed bearing date the  
tenth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eight  
and forty one. Together with all and singular the rights, members,  
hendiments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said John Watson his heirs and  
assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and  
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the  
said premises unto the said John Watson his heirs and assigns  
against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever law  
fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

by William Fisher of State & District aforesaid to me granted bargained sold  
and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said William Fisher a certain tract or parcels of land in State &  
District aforesaid on the waters of Mill Creek adjoining lands of Horatio  
Ashby "Mofford" & others Beginning at a chain 1 and bears NNE 827 chs  
to a pine tree thence 176 10 11 chs to a low oak thence NNE 8 8 chs to  
a pine tree thence 176 10 29. to a post oak thence E 10 chs to a low  
ironwood tree NNE 176 24 ch 40 Link. to a black gum thence NNE 176 10 20 chs 10 ft  
to red oak thence NNE 176 10 10 chs to a chestnut. Thence NNE 176 10 10 chs 10 ft  
beginning corner One hundred acres more or less. Together with all and  
singular the rights, members, hendiments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging thereto in anywise incident or appertaining. To him  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
William Fisher his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my  
self, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend  
all and singular the said premises to the said William Fisher his heirs  
and assigns against me and my heirs and against any person or  
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
