Any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. and it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made in payment of the abovesaid sum as before set forth and the intent for the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the said John W. Grotwell peaceably and quietly to hold use and occupy possession and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and succeeded and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoif anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
