Moore as commissioner of the said court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of three Dollars paid by the said Martha A. Larson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained, sold and declared and by the present doth grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Martha A. Larson her heirs and assigns all that lot of land lying and being within the town of Greenville and known as the Richardson's lot and as tract or lot No. 1 as will appear by reference to the return of the commissioners to the writ of partition (see plat of the same attached hereto) together with all and singular the hereditaments, rights, members, and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title interest power, possession, property, benefit, claim, and demand whatsoever both at law and in equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Vandy A. McBee deceased and of the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from, or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said land with its hereditaments, privileges, and appurtenances unto the said Martha A. Larson her heirs and assigns, to her and them only for her use, benefit and behoof forever, in witness whereof the said James P. Moore as commissioner of the said court under and by virtue of the said Decree hath hereunto set his hand and the seal of the court on the day and year first above written.

McBee his heirs and assigns the undivided half of tract No. 3 known as the house lot in the village of Greenville as will more fully appear by reference to the plat herewith attached and the return of the commissioners to the writ of partition together with all and singular the hereditaments rights, members, and appurtenances whatsoever to the said lands belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, power, possession, property, benefit, claim, and demands whatsoever both at law and in equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Vandy A. McBee deceased and of the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from, or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said land with its hereditaments, privileges, and appurtenances unto the said Vandy A. McBee his heirs and assigns to her and them only for her use, benefit and behoof from the witness whereof the said James P. Moore as commissioner of the said court under and by virtue of the said decree hath hereunto set his hand and seal of the court on the day and year first above written.
