

Grantor bargained sold & released and by this instrument do Grant bargains sell & release unto the said John M Brightmore all that piece parcel or tract of land containing one hundred to two by Mr. Fuller by Deed bearing date July the 30th 1863 (Except a small tract of land conveyed by me to James C Houston by Deed dated December the 12th 1865) & to Mr. Fuller by M. D. Dickey by deed dated July the 30th 1867 & to the said M. D. Dickey by J. H. Fuller July the 16th 1858, situated in the State & District aforesaid over both sides of Neals Creek running of the South fork of Cooper River containing three hundred and fifty acres more or less and same are as follows (S.E) Beginning on a Dogwood tree 34 1/2 E 18 2/3 chains to a Sassafras & Chestnut tree 100 ft from the Houston line to a Stake 34 chains to a Stake 34 1/2 Thence N 20 1/2 W 64 1/4 E 47 1/2 chains to a Stake 34 Thence N 64 1/4 W 63 1/2 chains to a Stake 34 Thence N 39 1/2 E 10 1/4 chains to N 30 1/2 E 10 1/2 Thence S 60 1/2 W 10 1/2 to a Stake 34 Thence S 47 1/2 E 15 1/2 chains to N 0 34 Thence S 62 1/2 W 13 1/2 14 chains to a Stake 34 N 45 W 10 1/2 chains to a Maple & Chestnut tree up said 24 1/2 chains to a Persimmon & Thence N 58 1/2 E 18 1/2 chains to a N. after date with interest from date for the sum of  
Two Hundred and Six Dollars one date the fourth  
day of December eighteen hundred and sixty seven  
the other note payable five years after date with interest  
from date for the sum of Two Hundred and Six  
Dollars and date four the December eighteen hundred  
and sixty seven referred to said notes will now  
fully appear. Now the said Isaac Bearfield witnesseth that the  
said Abraham Collins for and in consideration of the said  
debt or sum payable by aforesaid date for the better  
securing the payment thereof to the said Isaac Bear-  
field according to the tenor of the two stated Notes  
above and also in consideration of the sum of Two  
Hundred and Six Dollars by the said Isaac Bearfield to the said Abraham  
Collins in hand paid and before the sealing and this  
day of this present do grant bargain sell alienate lease  
pardon and confirm unto the said Isaac Bearfield  
and to his heirs and assigns forever all that piece  
of land and tract of land situated in Greenville Distri-  
ict Beginning at a Stake 34 the McElhany Road running  
Thence N 29 1/2 W 19 1/2 to a Spanish Oak 3 rods gone Thence N  
88 1/2 W 53 1/2 to a P. O. 34 pole Thence S 40 W 110 to a Stake 34  
Thence the State Roads to a Stake 34 and Thence W 11 1/2 to a Stake  
34 Thence to a P. O. 34 and the McElhany Ford Road Thence  
down the McElhany Ford Road to the Beginning bounded by  
dunes of Elijah Hill Thomas Chandler reference to a Plat  
Surveyed by J. H. Miller A. D. Oct. 1867 will now fully appear  
and by reference to a deed made to Abraham Collins by Isaac  
Bearfield and bearing date six the same year will  
also appear and containing Eighty four acres more or less  
together with all and singular the rights numbers and appur-  
tenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining and  
the reservation and reservations hereinabove mentioned  
unto issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said
