A. McCullum deceased should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purpose mentioned in their Decreed Order as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear and the said James P. Moon as Commissioner of the said Court after hearing duly advertised the said Land for sale by Public Auction on the first Monday of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Eight at the sum of one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Eight Dollars there openly and publicly and according to the Customs of Auctions sell and dispose of the said Land below described unto the said W. B. Johnson for the sum of One hundred Dollars being at that price the highest bid for the same. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said James P. Moon as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars paid him by the said W. B. Johnson the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted Bargained Sold and Released and by these Presents doth Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said W. B. Johnson his Heirs and Assigns all that tract or lot of land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid containing one hundred and Sixty five acres more or less all owing lands of Richard Woodlitt deceased John Morris Marshall Shettler and others the said tract of land conveyed by John W. Liggin to A. C. Tracy and from A. C. Tracy to W. A. McCullum by Deed bearing date (30th) October 1866, together with all and singular the hereditaments Rights Members and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the hereditaments and Appurtenances Rents Issues and Profits thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Power Possession Property Benefit Claim and Demand whatsoever both at Law and Equity of the Heirs and Representatives of the said W. A. McCullum and of the party to this Indenture and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by force or under threat or in than of them to have and to hold the said Land with its Glebe and

Privileges and Appurtenances unto the said W. B. Johnson his Heirs and Assigns to his uses their only proper uses and benefit and behalf former in witness whereof the said James P. Moon as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree doth seal his hands and the Seal of this Court on this day and year first above written Sealed and delivered in the presence of

Lying therewith all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenances, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alfred Davis his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self (my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alfred Davis his heirs and assigns forever against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
