rent out the said tract of land and to appropriate the produce  
thereof in any manner she may think proper without the inter-  
ference of her said husband or of any other person whomsoever  
and without being liable to the present or future creditors of  
her said husband or of any future husband in any manner  
whatsoever for and during the term of her natural life and at  
her death for the use and benefit of such child or children as  
she may legally surviving her share and share alike if there be more  
than one but should she die without leaving a living child or chil-  
dren and her said husband surviving in that event the said trustee  
is by these presents authorized to sell the aforesaid tract of land  
on a credit and pay one half over to the estate of W H Ashmore and  
the other half to her said husband or his estate and I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever
