and released and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release unto said J. B. Grammell all that tract  
piece or parcel of Land situate in the State and District  
aforesaid on Waters of South Tyger River Bounded by  
my own Land and A. A. Stewart's Containing Fifteen and  
three fourth acres by the same more or less Beginning on a  
Chesnut-Tree Running S. 76° 20' E. and 10 links to a Chestnut  
on A. A. Stewart's Line thence N. 11° W. 6 rods and 8 links to a  
Hickory on said line thence S. 85° W. 20 chains and 45 links  
to a Chestnut-Oak thence N. 10° E. 10 chains and 85 links to the  
beginning Chestnut together with all and singular the  
rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said  
Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
to said and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said J. B. Grammell his Heirs and  
assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs  
Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend  
and all and singular the said premises before mentioned  
unto the said J. B. Grammell his Heirs and assigns against  
myself my Heirs and against every person or persons  
whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part
