Brady one thousand dollars for the same over & above in part he has already other moneys and to assume pay all debts now due by the late firm of Brady & Baister to including & save himself the said Brady against all debts damages and and the said firm as for both of the premises aforesaid and And the said James Baister has given the said Brady his bond with four equal twelve months for \$500.00 each bearing interest at rate of 10% per annum agreed to assume the debts aforesaid and to secure the payment of the same and for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to the said James Baister of the said Henry C. Brady by in said paid at and before the signing and delivery of these presents have granted bargained sold and released unto the said Henry C. Brady the lease of the said New Haven Paper mill two Paper Making Machines with all appurtenances belonging to the same four Wood Saw Stated Spindles for paper making stuff chests Calendars Rolling Machine Flat Iron Scales four rollers and all other fixtures and appurtenances for making paper at said mill and 2 Harnup two waggons and the stock at the Paper Mill manufactured or in process of manufacturing to the value of five hundred Dollars which may be taken at any future time and what amount is to be kept then at all times the Paper Mill was owned by W. C. A. Perkins situate lying & being on the River in Greenville County S. C. together with all and singular the rights tenements hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said H. C. Brady his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H. C. Brady his heirs and assigns against us and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Whereas as aforesaid and it is the true intent and substance of the Parties to these presents that if the said James Baister his heirs executors or administrators should will not fully pay or cause to be paid unto the said H. C. Brady the sum of One thousand dollars here and by the said debt first payable debts of the firm aforesaid stated & unto for the Paper mill as the said debt debts here now due according to the agreement above mentioned then and from thence forth these presents shall be utterly null and void anything herein contained to the contrary therof in any way notwithstanding. And it is Covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that
