Stull, appointed by the order and decree of the Court of Chancery, as the successor of William Thompson deceased and by virtue and execution of an order and decree of said Court I Thomas H. Stull Trustee as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Sarah C. Evans of Marlinton County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold released and conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant bargain sell release and convey unto the said Sarah C. Evans all that piece of land and tract of land containing twenty (20) acres more or less situated lying and being on the west side of the Rutherford Road between one and two miles from Greenville Court House in the County and State of aforesaid, adjoining lands of Frank Boyd, J. B. Thompson and others, and having the following lines and boundaries as set forth in a plot of the same made by G. S. Mason H. S. October 20. A. D. 1853, and annexed to the Deed of said land from Charles J. Elford to William Thompson, Trustee of Mrs. Thomas H. Stull and Mrs. Frances H. Stull, to wit Beginning at a Stake 10 rods East of the Rutherford Road and running thence with said road North 2 miles 11 chains 17 links to a Stake at thence with said road North 2.5 East 2 chains 10 links to a Stake at thence South 86 1/2 West 17 chains 50 links to a Stake at thence South 15 West 2 chains 60 links to a Stake at thence South 26 East 11 chains 41 links to a Stake at thence East 12 chains 46 links to the beginning being the same tract of land conveyed to Mr. and Mrs. Thompson, Trustee of Thomas H. Stull and Frances H. Stull, by Deed of Conveyance bearing date the first day of August A. D. 1855, by Charles J. Elford, together with all and singular the rights immovable hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to said land to have all and singular the said premises unto the said Sarah C. Evans, land her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself to defend and hold the said premises against all and singular the said Charles J. Elford, his heirs and assigns and all persons whomsoever.

Eighth Judicial Circuit of the State of South Carolina  
Signed at Greenville in said State on the thirteenth day  
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and sixty nine and in consideration of  
the sum of Two Thousand eight hundred and five Dollars  
are to me paid by Thomas Lake of Edgefield County in  
the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and re-  
leased and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said Thomas Lake all that piece of  
land lot of land situate lying and being in the City and  
County of Greenville in the State aforesaid containing  
three and Eighty three one hundredth acres more or less  
and having the following lines trees and bounds  
(viz) Beginning at a Stake on Dr. S. B. Marshall's line run-  
ning Thence N $70^{\circ}$  E $6^{\circ} 30'$  to a Stake on Dr. male line then  
up the said College line N $22^{\circ}$  E $9^{\circ} 30'$  to a Stake on back road  
thence with said street N $77^{\circ}$  W $2^{\circ} 30'$  to a Stake on Dr. S. B. Marshall's  
all line Thence with said line two chains and five links  
to the Beginning the said lot being lot number one of the  
lands known as the old Academy lands together with all  
and regular the right, privilege & convenience of
