Carolina the sum of two hundred and dollars with interest thereon one or before the first of January 1871 according to the terms and effect of the note above mentioned then and from thence forth these Presents shall be utterly null and void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. And it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these Presents that neither defendant shall be made no payment of the amount sum as before aforesaid forth and the interest for the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the said R. S. Burns of Greenville County South Carolina publicly and openly to hold the same occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and released and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have receive and take the rents and profits thereof to his own particular use & behoef of any thing herein contained to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding the nature whereof the said parties have been at set their hands and sealed the day and year first above written sealed and delivered in the presence of A. The above lot is purchased w<sup>th</sup> the partnership funds & our partnership account.
