This Indenture made the  
Twentieth day of January in  
the Year of our Lord one  
thousand Eight hundred and seventy between  
Sarah L. Butler of the County of Greenville  
of the one part and Lewis H. Shumate of the  
said County of State of the other part  
Witnesseth  
Whereas, the said Sarah L. Butler is justly  
indebted to the said Lewis H. Shumate in  
the full and just sum of Eight hundred  
dollars by her promissory Note bearing even  
date with these presents.  
Now this indenture witnesseth that the  
said Sarah L. Butler for and in consider-  
ation of the premises aforesaid, and also  
in consideration of the sum of Five dollars  
to the said Sarah L. Butler by the said  
Lewis H. Shumate in hand paid, at and  
before the sealing and delivery of these  
presents, have granted, bargained, sold,  
and released, and by these presents do  
grant, bargain sell and release, unto the  
said Lewis H. Shumate all that Lot or par-  
cel of Land situate and lying in the City  
of Greenville containing Ninety seven one  
hundredth acre beginning at a stake 3x  
and running thence S 19° W along College  
Street 234 to a stake & thence N 20° E 450 to  
a stake 3x thence N 69° E 200 to a stake 3x the  
two last lines bounded by the said L. H.  
Shumate thence E 17° N 450 to the beginning  
corner by Prof. Dr. Camp a lane or pass  
way twelve feet wide along the last line  
is hereby reserved for the use and benefit  
of the said L. H. Shumate and the said

Mrs. Butler respectively. Together with all  
and singular the rights, members, heredita-  
ments and appurtenances to the said prem-  
ises belonging or in anywise incident or  
appertaining to have and to hold, all and  
singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Lewis H. Shumate his heirs  
and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind  
myself my Heirs, Executors, and Administra-  
tors, to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises, unto the said Lewis  
H. Shumate his Heirs and Assigns, against  
me and my Heirs, and against every person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof.

Provided always, nevertheless, and it is  
the true intent and meaning of the parties  
to these presents, that if the said Sarah L.  
Butler her Heirs Executors or Administrators  
shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid,  
unto the said Lewis H. Shumate the sum of  
Eight hundred Dollars according to the tenor  
and effect of the promissory note above  
intended them and from thenceforth, these  
presents shall be utterly null and void, any  
thing herein contained to the contrary thereof  
in anywise notwithstanding. And it is cov-  
enanted and agreed upon by and between  
the parties to these presents, that until default  
shall be made in payment of the aforesaid  
sum as before set forth, and the interest  
for the same, it shall and may be lawful  
to and for the said Sarah L. Butler peaceably  
and quietly to hold, use, occupy, possess and  
enjoy all and singular the premises above  
granted and released, and every part  
thereof with the appurtenances, and to  
have, receive and take the rents, issues and  
profits thereof to her own particular use and  
 behoof, any thing herein contained to the  
contrary hereof in anywise notwithstanding.
