Mooney of Greenville County & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Alberry Ballenger and Mathew Ballenger of the State & County aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell release unto the said Alberry Ballenger & Mathew Ballenger a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the State & County aforesaid on both sides of Morgan's Creek branch waters of Middle Tyger river Beginning at a chestnut oak thence N 20 E 21 ch to a W. O. & thence N 19 ch to W. O. & on Rethers branch thence N 22 W 12 ch to a W. O. & thence S 71 W 11 ch to a rock in the old field thence S 10 E 14 ch to a W. O. & thence S 24 W 14 ch to a P. O. thence N 65 E 25 ch to the beginning also the saw-mill place bounded as follows. begining on the south end of the saw-mill dam thence a course south of East forty or forty yards to a fork'd Rd.
