To Beattie	For Lot	I know all men by these presents that I Otis Mills of Charleston District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of eighteen hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Hamlin Beattie of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Hamlin Beattie all that piece or lot of land containing one and two thirds acres lying being and situate in the town of Greenville District of Greenville and State aforesaid bounded as follows beginning at a stake on the Laurens Road S E corner of Elford's Lot 1 Beattie's Lot, running thence with said Laurens Road (20 1/2) Two hundred and one and half feet to a stake opposite the front of Beattie's south west corner thence with a forty feet street 34 2 1/4 three hundred and forty two and one half feet to a stake being the south east corner of another lot of C J Elford also conveyed by this deed, thence with said lot 220, two hundred and twenty feet to a stake on line of first named lot of C J Elford, lot now Beattie's, and thence with said lot 34 2 1/4 three hundred and forty two and three fourths feet to the beginning corner on the Laurens Road being same lot conveyed to me by Theordore D Wagner by deed dated the sixth day of September 1866 and also another lot described as follows containing nearly one half acre lying being and situate in the town of Greenville and District of Greenville and State aforesaid and having the following lines, metes and bounds, beginning at a stake on Ingles Street (Penholme St E corner), and running thence with said street N E One hundred feet to a stake C J Elford S E corner thence with Elford's lot N E two hundred and thirteen feet to a stake on Elford's Beattie's line thence with Elford's, now Beattie's One hundred feet to a stake Penholme N W corner and thence with Penholme S E two hundred and two feet to the beginning

Wilson Cook	For Lot	I know all men by these presents that I Hamlin Beattie of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred dollars to me paid by Wilson Cook of Greenville County in this State aforesaid have granted, bargained and sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Wilson Cook all that piece or lot of land containing one and two thirds acres lying and situate in the City of Greenville and State aforesaid, bounded as follows beginning at a stake on the Laurens Road S E corner of C J Elford's lot now Beattie's lot, running thence with said road 20 1/2 Two hundred and one and one half feet to a stake opposite the front of Beattie's S W corner, thence with a forty feet street 34 2 1/4 three hundred and forty two and one fourth feet to a stake being the S E corner of and the lot of C J Elford also conveyed by this deed thence with said lot 220, two hundred and twenty feet to a stake on line of first named lot of C J Elford, now Beattie's, and thence with said lot three hundred and forty two and three fourths feet 34 2 1/4 to the beginning corner on the Laurens Road being lot conveyed by D Wagner a lot 34 2 1/4
