And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises subject to the provisions, conditions and limitations above mentioned unto the said Hamlin Beattie Trustee as aforesaid his successors heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
