claim the same or any part thereof. I recinded always
nevertheless and it is true intent and meaning of the
parties to these presents that if the said William Pearson
his heirs and executors or administrators shall well and
truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Woodriss
the sum of four hundred Dollars above mentioned according
to the Seal Note then and from thenceforth these presents
shall be entirely null void anything herein contained to the
contrary notwithstanding. And it
is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties
to these presents that until default shall be made in
payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth. And
the interest for the same it shall and may be lawfull
to and for the said William Pearson peaceably quietly to
hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and singular
the premises above granted and released and every part thereof
with the appurtenances and to have receive and take
the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular
use and behoof anything herein contained to the contrary
being in any wise notwithstanding. And witness whereof
