

Wth said for and in consideration of the sum of Four
Hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by
R. C. Pool of said State and County the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have made her joint
and release and by these presents doth grant
sell and release unto the said R. C. Pool his heirs and
assigns a certain piece several or tract of land situated
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on
the North bank of the River river Beginning at a Stake
at the mouth of a ditch running off the Stake
in front of the old bridge across the River
on the south side of the same bridge
to a stone 30 m^l in the edge of the
bottoms there S^E 1/4 th^g 1/4 of 23 ch^g across Bridge made
to Maple St one on each side above the mouth
of said Branch to a stone 30 m^l in the edge of the
bottoms there S^E 1/4 th^g 1/4 of 28 ch^g to a Stake 37 rods or
length of said North bank of River river there
down the meanders of said river to the beginning
corner and continuing nearly a rod or less
and bounded by bounds of said J. H. Pool Farms
Mine and others together with all and the rights
privileges hereinafter and appurtenances to the
same belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining to have and to hold all and singular
the said premises with the appurtenances unto the
said R. C. Pool his heirs and assigns forever and
I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and forego against the
said premises unto the said R. C. Pool his heirs assigns
against myself my heirs and against every other
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 8th
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and forty two (1872) signed sealed
