Greeting Whereas Absalom B. Tally son or widow the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of July A.D. 1871 did exhibit his Petition in the Court of Probate  
at the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville and State  
of South Carolina. Against H. Perry Bates Mary B. Bates and Absalom  
Tally against the cause being at issue before the Honorable  
Judge Douthet, now to be held on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of  
October A.D. 1871 when the said court after full hearing  
and due deliberation in the premises did order  
and decree that the tract of land belonging to  
the said C. H. Bates of Rowles, S. P. Tally deceased and Absalom B.  
Tally his wife by them by the will of Absalom Blythe  
now deceased remittes mentioned, and described should  
be sold in Absalom B. Tally of the sum of Two thousand  
and two hundred Dollars the appraised value of the  
same now known all men that I the said S. P. Douthet, Judge  
of Probate of Greenville County in consideration of the  
pecuniary and also in consideration of the sum of Two  
thousand and two hundred Dollars paid me by the said  
Absalom B. Tally the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
for one hundred Dollars sold and released and by these  
present do grant Bargain sell and release unto the  
said Absalom B. Tally his heirs and assigns All that Tract  
of land situate lying and being in the State and County  
aforesaid on waters of South Saluda River adjoining lands  
of Absalom Blythe, Beverly Thompson and others and  
containing six Hundred and sixty five Dollars more or  
less as will more fully appear by difference being made to  
the Plat of the same made by order of the Court together  
with all and singular the rights, Members, hereditaments &  
appertinances whatsoever to the said tract of Land be  
concerning or in any wise appertaining and the revenue  
and remainder rents, issues and profits thereof And  
also all the state rights title interest and other possession  
property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both  
at law and in equity of the said Rowles, Tally Dec'd  
and of all the parties to the said suits and of all other  
persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
part thereof by whom or under whom or either of them so  
have and to hold the said Tract of Land with its  
hereditaments improvements and appertinences unto the said  
Absalom B. Tally his heirs and assigns forever, In  
witness whereof I the said S. P. Douthet Probate Judge of  
Greenville County witness and by virtue of the said  
decree done Remm'st my hand and seal at the  
city of Greenville this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January in the  
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
