 The State of South Carolina This
 Indenture made and entered into on
 this day of in the
 year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy three
 between John H Walker of Greenville County in the State
 aforesaid of the first part, and Amanda Walker his wife
 of the second part Testifico That whereas divers disputes and
 unhappy differences have arisen between the said parties for
 which reason they have consulted and agreed, and do hereby consent
 and agree to live separate and apart from each other for and
 during the remainder of their natural lives And this Indenture
 further witnesseth that the said party of the first part in considera-
 tion of the premises and in pursuance thereof does hereby, con-
 cern promise and agree to and with the said party of the second
 part that it shall and may be lawful for her at all times here-
 after to live separate and apart from him, and that he shall
 and will allow and permit her to reside and be in such place
 and places and in such family and families, and with such
 relations friends and other persons, and to carry on such trade
 or business as she may from time to time choose or think fit.
 And that he shall not, nor will at any time sue or suffer her to
 be sued for living separate and apart from him, or compel
 her to live with him; nor sue molest, disturb or trouble any
 other person whosoever for receiving entertaining or harboring
 her; and that he will not without her consent visit her, or
 knowingly enter any house or place where she shall dwell res-
 or be, or send or cause to be sent any letter or message to
 her; nor shall or will at any time hereafter, claim or demand
 of her any of her money, jewels plate clothing household
 goods furniture or stock in trade which she now has in
 her possession or shall have in the future.

at any time hereafter otherwise acquire and that she shall
 and may enjoy the same and absolutely dispose thereof as
 if she were of her sole and unmarried and further that the
 said party of the first part shall and will well and truly
 pay or cause to be paid for and towards the better support
 and maintenance of the said party of the second part the sum
 of One hundred and twenty five Dollars And he does furthermore
 give ground, bargain, sell and in plain and open market de-
 liver to the said party of the first part, all the household
 and kitchen furniture, which she had when they were first
 married, and also one cow four Shotts three fat Hogs three
 head of cattle, three loads of Hay, one hen of Ducks, thirty bush-
 els of Potatoes, ten bushels of Turnips and forty bushels of
 corn, which the said party of the second part does hereby
 agree to take in full satisfaction for her support and main-
 tenance; and all alimony whatever And the said party of
 the second part in consideration of the premises, and of the
 sum of One hundred and twenty five Dollars aforesaid and
 the personal property above enumerated does hereby renounce,
 release and forever relinquish unto the said party of the
 first part all her interest and estate and also all her right
 and claim of Dower of in or to all and singular the real
 estate of the party of the first part, which he now owns
 to him and his heirs and assigns forever and also all her
 interest present or contingent in his personal estate And the
 said party of the second part hereby covenants and agrees
 to and with the said party of the first part that in case
 she survives him she will not after his death make any
 claim whatsoever, either in person or by Attorney or Agent
 to any portion of his estate real or personal, hereby renouncing
 and releasing all her interest therein to him and his heirs
 and assigns forever And the said party of the first part is to
 be henceforth freed from all debts and obligations contracted
 or to be contracted by the said party of the second part in
 any manner whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said
 parties have hereunto set their hands and seals on
