 heirs at law of both Jeremiah Cleveland died of Greenville in
 the State aforesaid in consideration of Eight hundred dollars.
 Due to us paid by Jnoas M Edwards of Greenville County in
 the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
 said Jnoas M Edwards All that plantation and tract of Land
 containing Two hundred and fifty Acres more or less situate
 and being in the County and State aforesaid originally granted
 to John Daniel Kean beginning on a stake corner running
