 Carter Farmer Thal, <sup>Entered</sup> This agreement made and  
 entered into on the fifteenth  
 day of October in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred  
 and seventy five between Samuel Bradbury of the first part and  
 Carter Farmer and Martha Farmer of the second part all  
 of Greenville County in said State witnesseth that the said  
 party of the first part has rented and leased and does hereby  
 rent and lease unto the said parties of the second part  
 for the full period of one year from the first day of  
 December next all his piece heretofore and tract of land  
 situate lying and being on the White Horse Road in Greenville  
 County South Carolina and known as the "Whiteford  
 Spring" place. And the said parties of the second part  
 hereby covenant and agree to and with the said party of  
 the first part to pay him for said place the sum of  
 Two hundred and fifty Dollars per annum and to secure  
 the payment thereof hereby bargains sell and deliver to the  
 said party of the first part the following chattels that is  
 to say two Sow Mare Mules and One Sowl Horse mule  
 each about ten years old and One grey Mare about five  
 years old. This deed of bargain and sale to determine upon  
 payment of the rent aforesaid at or before the expiration  
 of the lease and the parties of the second part are to obtain  
 possession of said stock until default. And the said  
 parties of the second part for the purpose of further  
 securing the payment of the rents aforesaid do hereby  
 give to the said parties of the first part a lien upon  
 all crops to be raised on said place during the tenancy  
 hereof created said lien being under the act of Assembly  
 of this State of September 1866 and the various amendments  
 thereto. And the said parties of the second part further  
 covenant and agree to and with the said party of the  
 first part to cultivate said place in good husbandlike  
 manner to cut no timber and clear no land thereon  
 to keep the house and fences in repair and to return  
 the premises in good order at the expiration  
 of the term hereby extending the lease herein contained  
 to the securing of these covenants.
