 A. Strauds of Greenville County in the State aforesaid  
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these  
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
 said Mrs Mary A. Strauds all that tract or parcel  
 land containing One hundred and twenty nine (129) Acres  
 more or less, Beginning at Station Corner between N 1/4 &  
 11 1/4 E 21 1/2 ch to Soplar corner thence S 1 1/4 E 2 1/2 ch to stone  
 corner thence S 88 1/2 E 3 1/2 ch to B 0 corner thence  
 N 1 1/4 E 3 1/2 ch to the beginning corner bounded by  
 lands of John B. Johnson, John Balow, David Gunter  
 and Vaughn and which is more fully represented by a  
 Plat in part made by W.A. Holton Oct 19th 1863  
 together with all and singular the rights, members, heredit-  
 itaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-  
 ing, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and  
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said Mrs Mary A. Strauds her heirs and  
 assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my  
 heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and  
 forever defend all and singular the said premises  
 unto the said Mrs Mary A. Strauds her heirs and assigns  
 against myself and my heirs and every other person  
 whatsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or  
 any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 15<sup>th</sup>

 eight hundred and seventy five and in the one hundred and  
 first year of the independence of the United States of America
