 said H. M. Smith Sheriff as Sheriff as aforesaid, under and  
 by virtue of the said decree and in consideration of the sum  
 of Five Hundred and ten Dollars to him paid by the said Elizabeth  
 M. Jenkins the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 both granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
 doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elizabeth  
 M. Jenkins her heirs and assigns all that piece of land and  
 tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville  
 and State aforesaid being a portion of the land described in  
 the adings and thirteenth part of said land  
 containing ninety and one half acres more or less see plat  
 attached to this Deed for particulars. Together with all  
 and singular the rights members hereditaments and apparte-  
 nances to the said Real Estate belonging or in any wise incident  
 or appertaining; and the reversions and remainders rents
