 State aforesaid for and in consideration of Seven Hundred and fifty  
 Dollars to me paid by Mary E. Jenkins of the State and County  
 aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by  
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
 Mary E. Jenkins a certain piece or parcel of land lying and  
 being in Greenville County and State aforesaid and on the  
 North East side of South Tyger River joining lands of  
 Allen Rees Elizabeth Jenkins Susan Kendrick Pandolfini  
 Beginning on Allen Rees line at the River and State Thence N  
 $59\frac{1}{4}$  E 30° 28' to Stone Thence S 23° 44' W 23.60 to Stone 3 x Thence South  
 $59\frac{1}{4}$  W 26.15 to Stone 3 x Thence S 80° 12' W 11.00 to the centre of a  
 ditch Stone, Thence down the River to the beginning as the said  
 River now runs including half the bed of the river Cont-  
 aining Ninety One Acres and a half Together with all and  
 singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining,  
 To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the  
 said Mary E. Jenkins and to her heirs and assigns forever,  
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
 administrators to warrant and forever defend the said  
 premises unto the said M. E. Jenkins and to her heirs  
 and assigns against me and my heirs and against ever  
 other persons or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming  
 or to claim the same or any part thereof.
