 Asa B. Harrison of the County and State aforesaid have given granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do give grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said Asa B. Harrison all that
 tract or lot of land lying and being in the County of Greenville in
 the South side of Taxe's Creek water of South Tyger River Beginning
 on a Chestnut on the bank of said creek and running thence S
 16 W 1/2 chains to a Pinenom thence S 84 W 1/2 chains to a bir-
 cham. thence S 7 E 7 1/2 chains to a white Oak. thence S 36 1/2 W 1/2
 chains to Red Oak. thence S 12 1/2 E 2 1/2 chains to a Pine. thence S
 6 1/2 E 5 1/2 chains to Chestnut. thence N 14 W 1/2 chains to a S. S. Oak
 thence N 12 E 1/2 chains to Stake on bank of said creek thence
 along the meanderings of said Creek to the beginning or corner con-
 taining two hundred acres according to the plat made by
 John H. Hoyle March the 4 1845 be the same more or less
 together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and sin-
 gular the premises before mentioned unto the said Asa B.
 Harrison his heirs and assigns forever. Provided always, and
 these presents are upon this special trust and confidence
 upon this express condition, that he the said Asa B. Harrison
 or his heirs executors administrators and assigns shall
 so permit and suffer me the said James Harrison husband
 wife Margaret Harrison to wear, keep and enjoy a good and
 sufficient support and maintenance out of the proceeds
 rents issues & income of the said tract of land before men-
 tioned during the term of our natural lives and that from
 and after my decease, and the death of my wife Margaret
 Harrison her the said Asa B. Harrison his heirs executors ad-
 ministrators or assigns shall or lawfully may have hold
 and enjoy the said premises and every part and parcel there-
 of and dispose thereof and convert the same to his and their
 own proper use and behoof as he or they shall think fit.
