Know all men by these presents

that I the Owner of Greenville
County, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of Two hundred Dol-
lars to me paid by W A Henderson of Greenville County, in the
State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
said W A Henderson all that lot of land situate on Cox Street
in the City of Greenville containing 10,360 square feet more or
less beginning at a stake 3m on the East side of Cox Street
89 E 148 feet to a stake 3m thence N 3 W 10 feet to a
stake 3m thence N 85 W 148 $\frac{1}{4}$ ft to a stake 3m on said
Cox Street along said street 83 E 8 feet to the beginning
corner bounded by said Cox Street lots 2, 11 & 4 and more part-
icularly known as lot 183 in the Survey of H C Johnson
made May 10 1846

Together with all and singular the rights, members, heredita-
ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said W A Henderson his heirs and assigns forever, and
do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises, unto the said W A Henderson his heirs and assigns
against myself and my heirs and every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming unto claim the same or any
part thereof.
