Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said General Charles his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said General Charles his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof.
