the same may in anywise concern, I B. J. Douthit Judge of Probate of
Greenville in the said state send greeting: Whereas Sophia B Edwards
on or about the 26th day of March in the year One thousand eight
hundred and seventy seven did exhibit her petition in the Court of
Probate at Greenville Court House in the County of Greenville and State
aforesaid, against Elizabeth W. Dozier William M. Edwards
Alice L. Edwards and Charles H. Edwards. And the cause,
being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be
heard on the 9th day of May One thousand Eight hundred and
seventy seven when the said Court, after a full hearing thereof,
and mature deliberation in the premises, Did order, Adjudge and
Decree that the tract of land belonging to the Estate of Peter
L. Edwards deceased hereinafter mentioned and described, should
