Curry line, thence with said Curry's line to peninsula, thence with said Curry's to Garret, Garret, & Bowman Rock corner thence with Bowman line to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances in the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said W. Bowman & Co. their heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said W. Bowman & Co. their heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, onto claim the same or any part thereof.
