aforesaid for in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Demarcus R Poole of Bellevue in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Demarcus R Poole all that tract or parcel of land being a portion of and on the Eastern side of my Bellevue farm commencing at a Red Oak on the road from the merchant mill to said Poole's and running thence N 7° E 60 poles to a stake on Henry Beegars line thence with said line N 80° E 30 p 15 L to a maple corner of said D R Poole's home place thence down the meanders of said Branch S 6° E 71 p to a dog wood thence downward across said branch S 88 W 81 p to a rock corner thence S 68 W 18 poles to the creek and thence up the creek N 35° W 17 p to a stake thence N 7° E 18 p to the Black Oak beginning corner on the road containing twenty two acres levit the same more or less
